**Product Description:** CambridgeOne is home to Cambridge University Press & Assessment's English Learning digital online publishing propositions; further supporting the integration of learning and assessment, offering improved user experience, and enabling responsive development based on customer feedback, leading to frequent improvements to the customer experience.

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**Notes:** The CambridgeOne Platform was assessed against the [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines WCAG 2.2](#) as of the date of this report. The accessibility conformance report with the WCAG 2.2 Success Criteria, has been scoped for full pages, complete processes, and accessibility-supported ways of using technology as documented in the [WCAG 2.2 Conformance Requirements](#) measured against AA standard.

**Evaluation Methods Used:** This website undergoes regular testing against the above guidelines by development and quality assurance teams. An external audit was carried out by the Digital Accessibility Centre (DAC), an organization which tests apps and websites to ensure compliance with web standards. The DAC has used TalkBack, VoiceOver, NVDA and JAWS as screen readers and Zoom text along with native magnification available in Android and iOS. Dragon Naturally Speaking (with IE) has been used for testing Voice activation. The audit has also included people with some disabilities (Color Blind, Dyslexic, Learning Disabilities, Deaf, Asperger's, Anxiety/Panic disorder) but do not require assistive technology.

The most viewed pages were also tested using accessibility testing tools by our website team with Screen reading software and magnifying software for Web and mobile browsers.
